



CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Cedar River Maintenance Dredging Project

The City of Renton Surface Water Utility will be constructing the Cedar River Maintenance Dredging Project. The project will remove approximately 120,000 cubic yards of gravel and sediments from a 1.25 mile stretch of the river from its mouth to the Williams Street Bridge. Additionally, unstable banks will be repaired, outfall from storm pipes will be improved, vegetation will be replanted, and invasive vegetation adjacent to the levee and floodwall will be removed. The result will be a reduced risk of flooding to private, public and commercial properties.

The contractor, Gary Merlino Construction Company, will start mobilizing equipment into the work area during the week of June 6. All in-water work will occur from June 16, 2016 through August 31, 2016. The work will begin with surveying the project, traffic control, installation of erosion and sediment control measures, and the construction of access points into the Cedar River. Beginning June 15, 2016, approximately four crews will be removing sediment from the Cedar River and conducting bank stabilization, and outfall improvements simultaneously. The last phase of the project will be levee and property restoration, and mitigation planting. The project is anticipated to end the first week of November.

Project construction is planned between 5:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday. Sunday work may occur between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. along the entire project, if needed.


Most construction work will be performed from the airport side of the river except around and upstream of the Logan Avenue Bridge and a few access points in the Cedar River Trail Park. Advance warning signs will be placed along the Cedar River Trail and major access points notifying users of limited access or detours within the construction zone. The east lane of East Perimeter Road may be temporarily blocked during working hours, but access will be restored by the end of each working day.
