

GARBAGE

These go in your green garbage cart.

Plastic:

Take-out containers

Styrofoam & packing peanuts

Caps & lids

Stretch wrap

Empty motor oil & antifreeze containers

Plastic bakery & meat trays

Plastic cups, plates & utensils

Empty prescription vials

Plastic bags, drycleaner bags*

**Tip: Bag plastic bags and take them to your grocery store for recycling.*

Paper:

Food-soiled frozen food boxes

Disposable diapers

Ribbons, wrapping paper or foil

Wax & plastic-coated cardboard

Dirty or soiled paper & facial tissue

Hardback books*

**Tip: Donate books to a local charity or school.*

Please:

- Bag all garbage.
- Double bag pet litter and waste, packing pellets, and cold ashes.
- Bulky items like mattresses, appliances, and building materials can be picked up by special arrangement for a fee.
- You can use old garbage cans and recycling bins for extra recyclables, yard trimmings, or for other uses around your home.

Glass:

Mirrors & window glass

Ceramics & dishes

Broken glass

Incandescent & halogen light bulbs only (no fluorescent tubes or bulbs)

Aluminum and tin:

Caps, rings & lids

Aluminum foil & foil trays

Empty aerosol spray cans

Oil containers

Hardened paint (leave lid off)*

**Tip: Use kitty litter or paint hardener to solidify latex paint.*

Metal:

Sharp or greasy metal

Metal caps & lids

Clothes hangers

Small non-working appliances such as toasters, microwaves, coffee makers etc

Alkaline Batteries

**Tip: Use rechargeable batteries. Many stores accept rechargeable batteries for recycling.*

Miscellaneous:

Bagged pet waste & litter



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
