_____ I agree to report a lost or stolen gate card to the airport office at (425) 430-7471. I understand there will be a \$50.00 non-refundable replacement fee for a new access card.

_____ I agree to wait at any vehicle gate until it fully closes behind me. I agree not to allow any "piggy-backing" vehicles through the gate.

_____ I understand that I am responsible for any guests that I may bring onto the airfield for the entire duration of their time on the airfield.

_____ I understand that this gate card will expire on the same day my driver's license expires. I also understand that if I don't use my access card within the preceding 365 days that it will be suspended.
